The BSc (Hons) Business Accounting offers an accessible route into an accountancy-based degree by providing a solid grounding in accountancy. Students will gain the understanding of other business functions in preparation for a career using key financial and business skills.

If you choose to study our four-year course, your studies will begin with a Foundation Year designed to boost your knowledge and help you meet the challenges of your degree. This leads onto the main three-year programme which includes modules intended to bring all students to a standard level of competence to pursue further study in accountancy.

As you progress through this course, you will be required to devote more time to ethics, governance and controversial accounting principles, and will study accounting rules and apply accounting skills. These skills will be developed through a choice of modules including: Financial Accounting and Management Accounting, Financial Project Management, and Personal Finance Behaviour.

How will I be taught?

All learning and teaching takes place in seminar sized groups and within these sessions you will be presented with a wide variety of learning opportunities including: formal lectures, seminars, guest speakers and online videos. During your studies, you will develop an ability to work well as a team, meet deadlines or be able to manage your workload effectively.

Career progression

There are many career and further study options open to graduates of this programme in the field of accounting, finance and business including; project management, business analysis, taxation, back-office finance positions in the City, and corporate finance. This programme currently benefits from some exemptions from various accounting bodies which may help your decision for future study or work.
