The International Year One - Business is a degree preparation programme for international students who want to study one of the many Northumbria University undergraduate business degrees, but don't quite have the right entry qualifications to gain direct entry in to year one.

The programme is the equivalent of the first year of these undergraduate degrees and on successful completion of the International Year One, you will join directly into year two of your chosen programme of study. By choosing an International Year One, you will still be able to complete your degree in three years.

How will I be taught?

We have a deep understanding of how international students learn and we have found that the combination of increased tutor interaction, consistent assessment and academic and English support leads to success. That is why, to support learning and assimilation into university life, the number of lecture and seminar hours are higher than on a standard undergraduate first year.

This increased time in the classroom is to support your learning and the development of skills that most UK students already have. You will study all your modules over three terms - giving you time to gradually build your skills and understanding of key concepts.

For those of you who require additional English language support, you will study a longer programme that includes a term of English preparation. The aim of this term is to improve your English language skills in speaking, reading, writing and listening alongside more academically focused skills such as critical analysis, reference and academic writing.

Further study

In order to progress onto your chosen undergraduate degree you must achieve 40% on your programme. Upon successful completion and subject to specific entry requirements, you can go on to join the second year of a range of business undergraduate degrees at Northumbria University:
