Want to build your English language skills to successfully study at a UK university?

Whether you intend to study at Foundation, Undergraduate or Postgraduate level in the UK, our online Pre-Sessional English course combines academic and social language skills to help you get there.

Why study Pre-Sessional English?

- Meet the English language entry requirements necessary of a QA partner university programme.

- Study a 5, 10 or 15 week course to develop your English language skills, before progressing onto your chosen course.

What will I study?

Through online social and academic activities and tasks, you will gain the necessary skills to successfully complete a UK university programme.

- **15 week programme:** focus on developing your reading, writing, speaking and listening skills, as well as vocabulary, grammar and pronunciation in both academic and social settings.
- **10 and 5 week programme:** develop the necessary language and academic skills required to achieve the most from your future degree through critical thinking, discussion and analysis.

On completion of the course you will be able to undertake all aspects required of university study, as well as confidently socialise in informal settings.

As the Pre-Sessional English is open to students from across the world the classes will be scheduled to meet the requirements for different time zones. Classes will be taught between 09:00 and 18:00 UK time. For more information, visit: **gahighereducation/pse**

Progression

Meeting the required English language score to satisfy the language conditions of your progression course offer, depends on a mix of continuous assessment and end-ofsemester examinations (not IELTS).

You are expected to apply for your progressing course separately, and meet all conditions of your offer.
