NOTE: Evidence of Level 2 English and Maths is required to complete the apprenticeship.

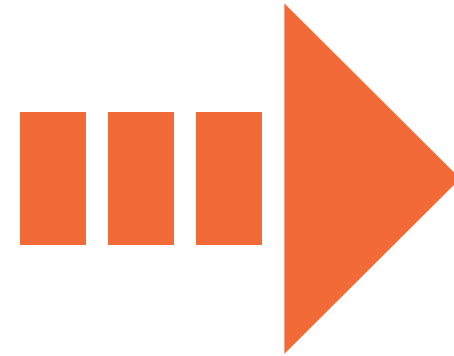
DURATION: 24 months + End Point Assessment, typically 6 months

MODE OF STUDY: Part-time, blended and work-based learning

START DATES: October, January, April, July

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: A minimum of a 2:2 Bachelor's degree or equivalent and a minimum of 2 years continuous workplace experience gained in a managerial or professional job following graduation

APPRENTICESHIP STANDARD: Senior Leader (Degree)

Learners start and end this MBA apprenticeship programme with modules focussing on leadership.

Chartered Management Institute (CMI)

All learners become 'Associate' members of the Chartered Management Institute (CMI) for the duration of study.

Successful graduates will receive a CMI Level 7 Diploma in Strategic Management and Leadership, with the potential to achieve full Chartered Manager status (CMgr), subject to meeting the professional work experience requirements

To achieve the Professional Accreditation (Chartered Manager Status) learners will complete a portfolio which evidences and demonstrates where they have met the knowledge, skills and behaviours that are expected of a Senior Leader. To demonstrate achieving this benchmark learners are required to submit evidence to the CMI (Chartered Management Institute) after which you will be attend a presentation with CMI assessors.
