

## Finance Terms and Conditions 2020/21

Please take the time to read the information below which relates to your fee payment.

You can either chose to self-fund your programme of study or apply for a tuition fee loan from Student Finance England, Student Awards Agency Scotland, Student Finance Wales or Student Finance North Ireland.

If you have applied for a tuition fee loan from Student Finance England (or regional equivalent) and this has not yet been approved you will still be permitted to enrol, on the basis that you are able to provide evidence of your application for tuition fee funding and a valid CRN number. However, please be aware that you are personally liable for any and all tuition fees incurred, even if you're subsequently found not to be eligible for some or all of the funding you have applied to obtain.

The value of your tuition fees are as shown in your unconditional offer letter.

The information below provides you with details of your fee liability if you withdraw from the course.

### Home/EU Students

Liability point 1 = 25% of course fee (if you withdraw or are withdrawn between the 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021 and 03<sup>rd</sup> January 2022)

Liability point 2 = 50% of course fee (if you withdraw or are withdrawn between 04<sup>th</sup> January 2022 and 03<sup>rd</sup> April 2022)

Liability point 3 = 100% of course fee (if you withdraw after or are withdrawn after 04<sup>th</sup> April 2022)

Self-withdrawal – you may choose to withdraw from your course, and can do so by following the withdrawal process as outlined in the University Regulations.

University Initiated withdrawal – QAHE and/or London Metropolitan University may terminate your registration at any point during your course, should there be a breach of Contract.

### International Students

For those students withdrawing from the programme or being withdrawn by QAHE or the university, the fee liability is calculated in accordance with the terms and conditions.
