## BSC (HONS) BUSINESS MANAGEMENT

Our course has been designed to support the development of values-driven professionals and equip them with the skills to be able to adapt to ever-changing business landscapes.

## BSC (HONS) COMPUTING

A hands-on degree programme that encourages students to develop an extensive knowledge of computer programming, culminating in a major final-year software development project.

- · Gain knowledge about databases, usability and web technologies, and networking
- · Learn transferable skills such as communication, teamwork and project management
- 9 12 hours of lectures, seminars and laboratory sessions per week
- Foundation Year available
- Tuition fee: £9,250 (per annum)

Entry requirement: 72-96 UCAS points

English language requirement: GCSE English at Grade 4 or above, IELTS 6.0 with no component less than 5.5 in each band, or equivalent

## FOUNDATION YEAR

Spend a year building up essential study skills and foundational knowledge, before progressing onto your chosen specialist undergraduate degree the following year.

- Fill in the gap between school and university
- Adjust to life as a university student

#### Entry requirement: 48 UCAS points

English language requirement: GCSE English at Grade 4 or above, or IELTS 5.5 with no component less than 5.0 in each band, or equivalent
