Upon successful completion of your International Foundation Programme, with a minimum of 40%, you will be guaranteed progression to your chosen undergraduate degree at the University of South Wales.

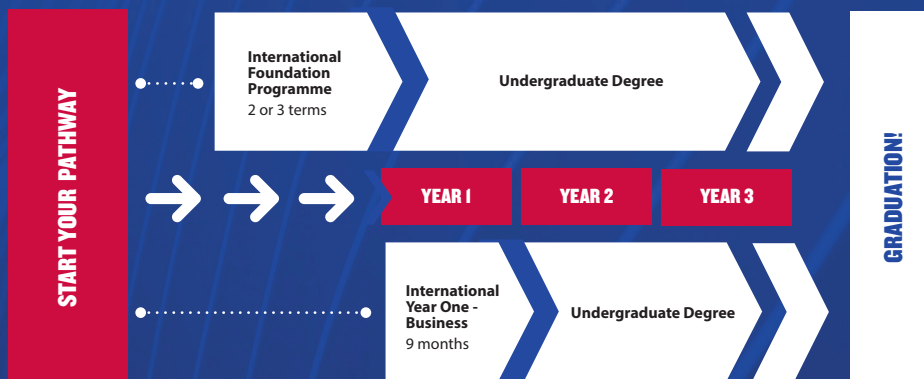
INTERNATIONAL YEAR ONE - BUSINESS
