

N.B. Please be aware that you will not have full functionality on a mobile device. Therefore, it is advised that you join your sessions using a PC or laptop where possible.


Joining a meeting and downloading the app

When using a mobile device open the email invitation to your session and click on 'Join meeting' or the link:






When using a mobile device for the first time, you will be prompted to download the Cisco Webex Meetings App:






You need to accept the Terms and Conditions:




Then click Join Meeting




Enter your meeting number name and email address (in order for your tutor to record your attendance).






If you have been instructed to get the WebEx session code from your timetable in <u>Semestry</u> download the app from the play store and then input the meetings details to join:







Audio and video set up




Once you have joined the session you can turn on your audio unless the host has muted all attendees. Muting and unmuting yourself:





The host appears in the top window, and you appear in the bottom window. Using your camera:








Interaction Functions

By clicking on the '...' icon at the bottom of the screen, you can find other functions:






By clicking on the person icon at the top right of the screen, you can access the chat function and choose who you want to chat with:







Choose from the list of participants who you want to chat to

Your question will appear in orange for your lecturer to see All Q&A (2) My Q&A (1)



Once your question has been answered it will appear in blue, with the answer directly below


You will also be able to see questions from your classmates which have been answered

Answer the questions and click 'submit':




If the lecturer shares the results, you will receive this pop up:



Captions


If the host turns on captions during the session, you will be able to see a transcription of what is said during the session in real time.





You can turn captions on and off here:










Breakout Sessions


If the host assigns you to a breakout session, you will see an invitation to join it:















Then click whiteboard to open a blank white screen.


screen' symbol.
