FIRST 2 SEMESTERS

The first two semesters are the same as the standard Masters

PENULTIMATE SEMESTER

You will choose between **two** options:

INTERNSHIP & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

A 15-week internship at an external company



APPLIED CONSULTING PROJECT
