# **FIRST 2 SEMESTERS**

The first two semesters are the same as the standard Masters.

### **PENULTIMATE SEMESTER**

You will choose between two options:

- 1. An Internship & Professional Development Project, a 15-week internship at an external company
- 2. An Applied Consulting Project, which involves working on a live business project in the industry

## **FINAL SEMESTER**

You will then complete your final semester, including either a Dissertation or Applied Research Project.
