How to apply

All our entry requirements can be found on our individual programme pages on our website. We accept a wide variety of academic and vocational qualifications for entry.

01

FIND YOUR PROGRAMME

Visit your chosen programme page and click on the "Apply Now" button to begin the online application process.

02

FORM & SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

Once we receive your fully completed application form and supporting documents, our Admissions team will assess your application.

03

CONDITIONAL OFFER LETTER

If you are a suitable applicant we will send you a conditional offer letter.

04

REVIEW

After meeting the conditions, your application will be sent to the faculty. If successful, you will receive an unconditional offer letter.

05

CONFIRMATION OF ACCEPTANCE

**International students only*

Once we receive your paperwork and payment, we will issue a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS). You can then apply for your visa through your local UK Embassy after meeting all UKVI requirements for a Student Route Visa.

06

ACCEPT & PREPARE FOR YOUR STUDIES

Once you have accepted your offer your place will be confirmed. While you wait for the programme to start, sort your finance and accommodation needs.

07

BEGIN YOUR STUDIES

Enrol and begin your programme.
