Pre-Master's Certificate: Study Skills	1 semester	January	7.0 (6.5 in all skills) or native/near-native speaker
Pre-Master's Certificate: English Language and Study Skills	1 semester	September, January or May (Distance Learning available for May entry)	6.0 (6.0 in reading and writing and 5.5 in other skills)
Pre-Master's Diploma: English Language and Study Skills	2 semesters	September or January	5.5 (5.5 in each skill)
Two-Year Master's Degree	2 years (Pre-Master's followed by master's on one application and one visa)	September or January	5.5 (5.5 in each skill)
